SET A. MODULE 1 - HELLO / MODULE 2 - MEET THE FAMILY

Grammar Focus: subject pronouns (I, you, she, he it, we, you, they) / possessive pronouns (my, your, her, his, its, our, their) / verb to be (all forms) / yes-no questions / Wh-questions (how old, what, where, who) / a, an / possessive 's.

. <u>Vocabulary</u>: countries, nationalities; numbers; prepositions: from (place), at, from-to (time); family members; jobs.

Reading and Listening: dialogues, a letter, a family description, numbers game.

- Listening: Everyday English: Meeting People / "Happy Birthday" (Ex. 4. Unit 1, Click On 1. Expess Publishing).
- Speaking: about favourites, about your family, about jobs; meeting people (role-plays); game: mixer.
- . Writing: an e-mail / a paragraph about you family / Review 1-2.

SET B. MODULE 3 - AT HOME

- Grammar Focus: have got has got / the a(n).
- . <u>Vocabulary</u>: homes; parts of the house; adjectives for description, colours; objects in rooms; prepositions: in.
- Reading and Listening: a dialogue, a letter; spelling.
- Listening: "Anita Roddick and Stan Bowles" (File 4C, English File 1. Oxford)
- Speaking: talking about possessions; saying telephone numbers; asking and answering (a quiz).
- Writing: a description of a room.

SET C. MODULE 4 - AT SCHOOL

- Grammar Focus: this, that / these, those; singular and plural nouns.
- . <u>Vocabulary</u>: the alphabet; the classroom, lessons, school objects, objects; parts of the school; prepositions: on.
- . Reading and Listening: dialogues; sentences.
- Listening: Everyday English: Interviews.
- Speaking: about families, the school, objects (guessing game); about lessons and projects spelling game.
- Writing: "My Ideal School" / Review 3-4.



SET D. MODULE 5 - GOING OUT

. Grammar Focus: imperatives; some / any.

Vocabulary: places in town, adjectives, instructions; food and drink, shopping; prepositions: near.

Reading and Listening: dialogues; instructions.

Reading and Writing: Culture Corner 1: "Cambridge Factfile" / Extra Time.

Speaking: about places / shopping and cafè situations (role-plays)

Writing: a description of a place.

SET E. MODULE 6 - PLAYING SPORT

. Grammar Focus: can / can't (ability); there is / there are.

Vocabulary: sports, athletics; adverbs; sports facilities, sports centres; times; prepositions: in, at (time).

. Reading and Listening: dialogues.

. Listening: Everyday English: Shopping / "What can you do?" (File 3C, English File 1. Oxford) / "My Favourite Room" (File 6B, English File 1. Oxford) / "Race the Clock: Madelaine's Day" (File 3D. English File 1. Oxford) / Song: "Your Song" (Elton John).

Speaking: about abilities, favourite sports and sport facilities; telling the time; asking and giving personal information (role-plays).

. Writing: completing a form / Review 5-6.

SET F. MODULE 7 - EVERYDAY / MODULE 8 - FREE TIME

. Grammar Focus: simple present (all forms and all persons); like + NOUN; like + V-ing.

Vocabulary: days; routines; activities; spare time activities; prepositions: on, in, to (direction).

Reading and Listening: dialogues, descriptions, questions; a survey.

Reading and Writing: Culture Corner 2: "Teenagers in Britain" / Extra Time.

Listening: Everyday English: A Survey / "Susy Stressed and Henry Healthy" (File 5A, English File 1. Oxford) / "Teresa Pons from Valencia" (File 5C, English File 1. Oxford) / Song: "Anything you Want" (Roy Orbison).

Speaking: about routines and days, relaxing: free time activities, hobbies and films; a dicussion; grammar game; game: guess the student.

Writing: "My School Day" / a letter / Review 7-8.

SET G. MODULE 9 - EXCURSIONS

. Grammar Focus: present progressive (all forms)

Vocabulary: places; transport (by bus, on foot); sightseeing (activities); clothes; prepositions: at, in, on (place).

. Reading and Listening: dialogues.

. Listening: "In your Free Time" (File 4D, English File 1. Oxford).

Reading: Culture Corner 3: "The Seaside" / Extra Time.





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Speaking: about transport ("How do you come to school?"); phone conversations (role-plays); talking about clothes; speaking game.

Writing: Tourist Information (a description / composition) / Interviewing a partner.

PRE-VIEW

Grammar Focus: recognition of past simple (all forms).

Vocabulary: points of time in the past: yesterday, ... ago, last...
